### 1. Review of April 2024 Meeting Minutes

• No feedback was received from PPG members regarding the minutes circulated from the April 2024 meeting.

### 2. Autumn COVID Vaccinations

- The Practice will offer COVID vaccinations to the adult cohort of patients, in conjunction with flu vaccinations.
- Eligible patient cohorts include all patients aged 75 and over, as well as those who are immunocompromised.

### 3. Flu Vaccinations for 2024

- Primary care orders flu vaccinations a year in advance to secure early delivery for optimal winter coverage.
- The vaccines are purchased by the GP partners. After administering the vaccine, the practice is reimbursed by the Prescription Pricing Authority approximately two months later.
- Unused vaccines cannot be returned to the manufacturer, resulting in a financial loss for the GP if not used.
- Predicting the required quantity of vaccines a year in advance is challenging due to uncertain patient uptake in the previous year. Delayed ordering can lead to late deliveries in the following year.
- This year, NHS England (NHSE) has imposed restrictions. Regardless of when flu vaccines are delivered, practices cannot administer them before Thursday, 3rd October 2024.
  - Vaccines given before this date will not be reimbursed.
  - Exceptions: Childhood flu vaccines and flu vaccines for pregnant women can be administered before 3rd October.

#### 4. **RSV Vaccination**

- From 1st September 2024, the NHS will roll out a new vaccination for Respiratory Syncytial Virus (RSV).
- This vaccination aims to protect older individuals aged 75–79 and newborn babies.
- Patients aged 75–79 as of 1st September 2024 and pregnant women (from week 28 of pregnancy) are eligible.

• The practice will contact patients in these cohorts to schedule vaccinations, with clinics starting on 5th September 2024.
